After completing the grant application, please email it to grants@complex-weavers.org by March 28, 2025

To prepare your grant application, please create a new document that addresses all the questions below. Save it as a pdf and submit to the email address shown with any supporting images either included in the document with captions or attached to the email with clear file names.

Please include in your grant proposal:

- 1. Personal contact information: First and last name, phone, e-mail address, and postal address.
- 2. Does your proposed grant project involve learning/investigating advanced weaving technique(s) yourself or teaching the subject to others?
- 3. Project description: Tell us a story of what your project is about, why you want to pursue it and how the grant money will make it possible. Please include proposed starting date, materials needed to work on this project, proposed time schedule and process for completing the project, proposed end date, proposed method and date for sharing results with CW members, etc.
- 4. Explain how your project addresses each of the specified selection criteria:
 - A. Your continued development as an artist, weaver and/or teacher
 - B. The specified definition of advanced weaving techniques
 - C. Your capability to complete the project and fulfill grant requirements

- D. Feasibility of the project's proposed budget, supported with cost estimates
- E. The method to add to the knowledge base of other CW members
- 5. Provide a cost breakdown for this project, identifying which costs would be funded by the grant.
- 6. Up to \$2,000 of CW funds are available for the grant(s) offered this year. In the event CW does not award you the total amount you request, would you be able to complete the project? If not, please explain the reason.
- 7. Please provide references from two people who are familiar with you and your weaving practice. Including names and contact information. Make sure they know to forward their references to the above e-mail address by March 28, 2025.
- 8. Please tell us whether you are a:
 - 1. Current member of Complex Weavers, and for how many years?
 - 2. Student in post-secondary textile program, and which one?
 - 3. Not yet a member of Complex Weavers.

9. Should you receive a grant, you will be expected to provide an article describing the results and information about the subjects studied or taught for the Complex Weavers Journal. Please acknowledge that you agree to these conditions.
